

Montessori Teacher Academy



History

Founded in 1992 in Lake Forest, California, the Montessori Teacher Academy served the local community as the one and only Teacher Education Program in Orange County affiliated with the National Center for Montessori Education (NCME). In September 2003, the Teacher Education Program took residence in Dana Point, California, using Monarch Bay Montessori Academy as its demonstration school. Monarch Bay Montessori Academy houses over one hundred families in the southern California area and serves children at the Early Childhood and Elementary levels (2½ through 12 years). In June 2006, the Montessori Teacher Academy joined the American Montessori Society, AMS, as it united forces with NCME to become the largest Montessori organization globally.

Objectives

The Montessori Teacher Academy offers a Teacher Education Program of the highest academic standards, grounded in Montessori principles. This comprehensive training leads to a deep understanding and full embrace of the Montessori philosophy, curriculum, and methodology. Adult learners are guided in planning, developing, and organizing an ideal classroom environment that nurtures a child's natural development of order, concentration, coordination, and independence. They gain the knowledge and confidence to present Montessori materials and activities effectively, with a shared commitment to love, respect, and admiration for children.

This course prepares adults to meet children's individual needs and ensure the continuity of their learning experiences through the Montessori philosophy, theory, methodology, and practical implementation. Adult learners will demonstrate theoretical knowledge and apply research findings in child development and early childhood education. Additionally, they will become integral members of a school team, working well with co-workers and administration, and effectively communicating child development and early education concepts to other staff, parents, and the community.

Credentials



Montessori Teacher Academy prepares Montessori Teachers to meet the educational needs of children from 2 ½ to 6 years old.

The Montessori Teacher Academy offers a Montessori Early Childhood Credential accredited by MACTE and affiliated by the American Montessori Society. This credential qualifies Montessori teachers to educate children from ages 2 ½ to 6. MTA excels in maintaining the highest academic standards, ensuring that our teachers fully embrace the Montessori philosophy, curriculum, and methodology. This program cultivates quality Montessori teachers who are inspired to become lifelong learners.



After completion of the program, learners receive one of the three types of credentials depending on their current level of education:

01.

AMS Early Childhood Credential

Bachelor's Degree from an accredited 4year College or University, verified by official transcripts.

03.

AMS International Early Childhood Credential

Bachelor's Degree from an international institution verified by official transcripts.

02.

AMS Early Childhood Associate Credential

High school graduation verified by official transcript.
